Speakers' Biographies

Horace Cooper is a writer and legal commentator. He has been Counsel to the Honorable Richard K. Armey, Majority Leader of the United States House of Representatives from 1994 – 2002. Mr. Cooper is a Senior Fellow with the National Center for Public Policy Research and the Centre for New Black Leadership. He has held senior appointed positions in the presidential administration of President George W. Bush. His interests include the law and American society, intellectual property rights policy, the changing makeup of the United States Supreme Court, and political forecasting. He appears frequently on radio and television discussing these topics along with affirmative action, government reform and the efficacy of free markets. Mr. Cooper authored *She's No Million-Dollar Baby*, an op-ed on *Marshall v. Marshall* published this past April in LEGAL TIMES.

Craig Goldblatt is a partner in the Washington, D.C. office of the law firm WilmerHale LLP, where his practice focuses on complex civil and appellate litigation, with an emphasis on bankruptcy-related litigation and other restructuring matters. Mr. Goldblatt has represented debtors, creditors, secured lenders and asset purchasers in all stages of bankruptcy proceedings. Central to his practice are bankruptcy and insolvency related trial litigation and appellate proceedings in the courts of appeals to the U.S. Supreme Court. He has also been involved in a range of civil litigation matters outside of bankruptcy, with an emphasis on complex disputes and appellate litigation. Mr. Goldblatt has taught as an adjunct professor at the Georgetown University Law Center. He is a regular speaker at ABA, ABI and other professional conferences on bankruptcy matters.
