Keith Bergelt is the chief executive officer of Open Invention Network (OIN), the collaborative enterprise that enables innovation in open source and an increasingly vibrant ecosystem around Linux. Prior to joining the OIN, Mr. Bergelt served as president and CEO of two Hedge Funds—Paradox Capital and IPI. Previously, Mr. Bergelt served as a senior advisor to the technology investment division at Texas Pacific Group.

Kevin Jakel is the chief executive officer of Unified Patents, Inc., which addresses the risk and cost of non-practicing entity patent litigation by strategically protecting broad areas of technology, such as cloud storage or content delivery. Mr. Jakel previously served as Intuit's Head of IP Litigation. Prior to Intuit, he was a patent litigator with Kaye Scholer LLP and Howrey LLP where he represented clients in various technology areas. Mr. Jakel began his career as a patent examiner at the U.S. Patent & Trademark Office.

Tim Kowalski is Senior Patent Counsel at Google Inc., a position he has occupied since September 2012. Prior to joining Google, Mr. Kowalski was Lead Intellectual Property Counsel for Motorola, Inc. and Motorola Mobility LLC from 2004 to 2012. He began his legal career as an associate in private practice. Mr. Kowalski serves as a Director of the License on Transfer Network, Inc., an entity established by leading technology companies to reduce the number of patent infringement claims received from non-practicing entities that purchase patents for the sole purpose of enforcing them.
